

## Eisenhower Warns of Military-Industrial-Oedipal Complex

### Nation Increasingly Jealous of Relationship Between Pentagon, Big Business

'America Must Become Aware of Its Deep-Seated National Feelings,' Ike Says

WASHINGTON, D.C. — President Eisenhower, in his farewell address to the nation, warned Friday of the "growing, unwarranted influence of the military-industrial-Oedipal complex," which he said threatens to "undermine the most primal foundations" of society.

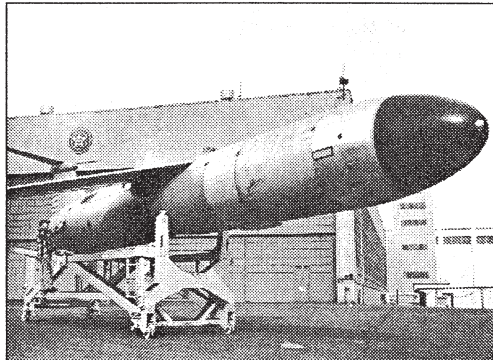
"It is, perhaps, natural," Eisenhower said, "that we Americans find ourselves snuggled so deeply in the protective, maternal bosom of the defense-contracting industry that we come to be jealous of—and at times, even loathe—the paternalistic military machine to which it is wedded. Nevertheless, it is vital for the future of our American family that we come to see the armed forces not as a rival for the affections of General Electric or McDonnell-Douglas, but as a stern yet loving hand, capable of imparting great wisdom and moving us beyond the era of inter-

national adolescence." Eisenhower appealed directly to the American people, asking them to demand that Congress hold regular, private, tri-weekly "sessions" with President Kennedy for the next four years. "By meeting regularly with the president in his office, your elected representatives will, over time, make fully conscious our country's deep-seated ambivalence about its own aggressive instincts. Only by bringing this ambivalence to the surface can we as a nation reconcile our military-industrial 'parents' with each other. Then, and only then, can America move forward and, with a new-found sense of individuality, establish a mature, stable relationship with the rest of the world."

The outgoing president urged Kennedy to shy away from "brash statements or strongly voiced opinions" about isolationism, the Suez crisis, CIA involvement in foreign politics, and early bed-wetting. "It is time to focus not on rhetoric, but on the issues—the latent, unconscious, primordial, archetypal issues that conflict millions of hard-working Americans every day."

But Eisenhower, who has met several times with Kennedy since his victory over Richard Nixon last November, seemed optimistic about the future. "What is needed now is a national transference, and, so long as his words and deeds encourage dialogue and uncover long-repressed memories of youth and idealism—and so long as he remains healthy—I believe Mr. Kennedy has the capacity to be projected upon more than any other president in history."

Speaking from his family's retreat on Cape Cod, Kennedy said he was "appreciative" of Eisenhower's comments and vowed to continue the psychological accomplishments of his administration. "Let the word go forth to friend and foe alike," Kennedy said. "The torch has been passed to a new generation of neo-Freudians, born in this century, tempered by war, disciplined by a hard and bitter peace, and alarmed by an eerie attraction to our mothers and hatred of our fathers."

## Jet-Age Technology to Revolutionize Hand-Drying

### Miracle 'Electric Towel' Is Germ-Free

#### Paper Waste Eliminated Forever

#### Ultra-Modern 'Swivel Nozzle' Allows Drying of Face, as Well

CINCINNATI, Ohio — The future is here.

A spokesman for Andrews & Hoyt, a Cincinnati-based industrial-appliance manufacturer, announced Friday that the company has perfected a revolutionary new "towelless" hand-drying device.

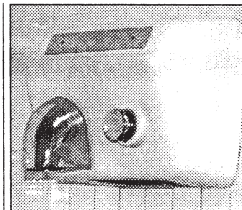
According to Lawrence Hoyt Jr., the device, which was developed using Jet-Age technology, will forever change the world of hand-drying.

"Just imagine going to the public rest room and drying your hands at the push of a button," said Hoyt, as he unveiled the device at the Greater Midwest Product Expo in Cleveland. "Never again will you have to use unsanitary towel paper, which can spread disease and cause severe chafing."

"This," Hoyt said, "is the promise of the Jet Age fulfilled, a pinnacle of modern technological achievement."

To facilitate operation of the futuristic device by laymen, a comprehensive list of instructions will be provided on a chrome plate affixed to the front panel of each unit.

Hoyt said he believes that, if these instructions are followed, hand-drying will reach a new era of convenience. "Once you push the 'On' button, then rub your hands gently under the warm

air, the hand-drying device will turn off automatically."

He added that, following the proper execution of the Jet-Age hand-drying procedure, wiping hands on pants will be an unthinkable course of action.

The Jet-Dry Hand-E-Blo, developed by Andrews & Hoyt over a three-year period at a cost of \$11 million, boasts a three-horsepower motor which blows a pleasant stream of warm air on the user's hands until they are dry. Its "On" button is of the same design as those on all the NASA rocketships. "This is a state-of-the-art button," Hoyt said.

Andrews & Hoyt, best known for its mid-'50s development of what would eventually become the "Wet-Nap" moist towlette, expects to have the new automated hand dryers installed in every public rest room in the U.S. by 1963.

## U.S. Cigar Lovers Call for Overthrow of Castro

### Ike Holds Emergency Meeting with Top Cigar Aficionados



HAVANA, Cuba — American cigar lovers are calling for the reinstatement of President Fulgencio Batista, whose recent overthrow by Communist guerrilla Fidel Castro has resulted in their being cut off from fine Cuban cigars.

"Communism must not be allowed to take root in Cuba," said Kenneth Landau, a real-estate developer and golf enthusiast from Palm Springs, Calif. "The thought of all those smokeables just 90 miles off the coast of Florida, with no way to get them into the country—much less the country club—is frightening."

"What am I supposed to smoke with my brandy, now that Cuba has cut herself off from trade with the U.S.?" asked Manhattan corporate attorney J. Walter Ruethven. "I'm certainly not going to settle for some cheap, poorly rolled American cigar. What kind of way is that to unwind? There must be some way to get that Castro out of there."

Meeting with top U.S. cigar aficionados at the White House Friday, then-President Eisenhower expressed concern and assured them that his successor will work closely with CIA Chief Allen Dulles to resolve the crisis.

"Unlike ourselves, Castro and his gang of Communist thugs have no appreciation for the finer things in life," Eisenhower told the esteemed smokers during a special four-hour Oval Office meeting. "He has no understanding of how nice it is to sit back in your favorite leather chair and light up a premium Coronado after a long, hard day at the office. Or how nice it is to smoke an aromatic Perfecto after sinking that 15-foot putt on the 18th hole to put you two strokes up and nail the victory. Castro and his band of goddess barbarians lack all such sensibility. Are these the kinds of neighbors the U.S. wants to keep? I think not."

Ruethven expressed hope that the U.S. military under Kennedy would act fast. "I am planning to purchase a brand-new '61 Eldorado convertible next summer," he said, "and all will be lost if I don't have a decent cigar to smoke while driving it to my beach house in the Hamptons. That Castro fink will pay dearly if I don't have one of Havana's finest in my hand by then."

### New Birth-Control Pill Expected to Greatly Reduce Unwanted Marriages

After nearly two years in development, Enovid-10, the first-ever commercially produced birth-control pill, is now available in the U.S. The new pill, which stops conception using hormones that fool the female body into thinking it is already pregnant, is expected to prevent upwards of 500,000 unwanted marriages a year.

"Every year in America, hundreds of thousands of sexually active young women unintentionally become married," said Dr. Gregory Pincus, the pill's creator, "By using Enovid-10, single women can now have all the sex they want with absolutely no fear of becoming burdened with a husband, a wedding or a lifetime of commitment."

No longer reliant on the flawed marriage-control devices of ages past, women across America are hailing the pill as a major breakthrough. "The pill seems like a much better way to avoid an unplanned marriage than the methods my friends have been using, such as suicide and the convent," said 19-year-old Christina Wyler of Stockton, Calif.

Said Indianapolis wife and mother Doris Tepper, 21, "If only they had that pill three years ago when I became unintentionally married after a night of unprotected passion in the back seat of my boyfriend's car! Now I'm forced to spend the rest of my life caring for a husband I never planned on having."

More than 1.6 million marriages were reported last year in the U.S. That number is expected to drop by as much as 60 percent by 1970.

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## Russian Man Is First in Orbit

### Will a Statue of Lenin Look Down on Us from the Moon?

### Alarmed Legislators Slash Education Budget to Fund Space Race

At 10 p.m. EST Sunday, the Russians launched a man into orbit around the Earth, claiming the heavens in the name of Communism.

"The Russians have captured space," Pentagon spokesman John Powell said in a somber official statement. "The national-security implications of this event are chilling, as the United States is now surrounded by 360 degrees of Communist-occupied vacuum."

In a mission lasting nearly two hours, Russian communaunt and vanquisher of millions of square miles of outer space Yuri Gagarin orbited once around the Earth at an altitude of 200 miles. It is unknown to which planets he may have directed his craft to plant the flag of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

In a statement to the press early this morning, President Kennedy pledged a swift U.S. response, warning of the dangers of an interplanetary "domino effect."

"If the moon falls to Communists, the planets may follow," he said. "Soon, if we do not act, our entire solar system could be under Communist rule."

Kennedy warned that, if Soviet scientists in space should ever come into contact with an intelligent life form from the outer planets, the beings might be brainwashed into supporting Communism before they can be reached by God's word and the U.S. Constitution.

The president met with CIA officials last night to discuss the possibility of conducting a covert outer-space coup.

The result of that meeting, according to inside sources, is a tentative plan to secretly arm and train space guerrillas to overthrow the Communists and install a solar-system government that is friendly to the United States.

American scientists are shocked by the Russian capture of outer space, which by all rights should be the exclusive domain of America. Scrambling to make sense of the defeat, they have so far been unable to determine how the Communists, unaided by the manifest destiny bestowed by God upon the United States, were able to out-

perform America in the race to the greatest frontier of all.

"This is a terrible blow to our quest for control of the fertile farmlands of Venus, Mars and the moon," NASA spokesman Harvey Teideman said. "The rich mineral resources of those territories are now under the direct control of Khrushchev's Red Army."

Teideman, along with other top NASA officials, has urged Congress to gut the nation's education and social-welfare programs and put more money toward the nation's space budget.

"Perhaps we cannot defeat the Soviet space fleet with our technology just yet," Teideman said. "But if we can, at the very least, launch a probe capable of distributing Bibles and American flags to all the planets in the solar system, it would be a great accomplishment, indeed."

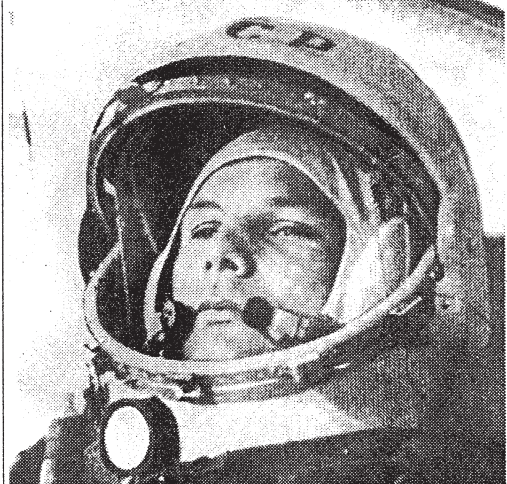
### Experts Say Teen Dance Shows May Be Symptomatic of Larger Problem

PRINCETON, N.J.—Top psychologists, therapists and behavioral scientists at Princeton's Institute for Family Studies released findings Friday indicating that popular teen dance programs on television, such as *American Bandstand*, may pose a long-range threat to American domestic stability.

Dr. Marwood Lohr, the psychiatric expert who conducted the 18-month study, detailed disturbing aspects of the trend, including the rumored existence of a mythical "Land of 1,000 Dances," where all responsibility is replaced by an infinite series of hedonistic gyrations.

"If we don't nip *American Bandstand* in the bud," Lohr said, "it will not stop with dancing. Within 10 years, we may have a full-blown 'youth culture' on our hands—a phenomenon which could sound the death knell of the well-ordered America we hold dear."

Lohr called upon the three television networks to replace all teen dance programs with dramatic plays about life during the Great Depression.

## Kennedy at Berlin Wall: 'Ich Bin Ein Ivy-League Playboy Millionaire'

BERLIN—President Kennedy, speaking before a crowd of 150,000 West Germans near the Berlin Wall Sunday, was greeted with wild applause when he opened his speech in the German tongue, proclaiming, "Ich bin ein Ivy League playboy millionaire." "People of the German Democratic Republic, I am proud and happy to be speaking to you on this momentous occasion," said Kennedy, making his first European visit since taking office. "I am also incredibly rich. Jawohl, meine Freunden, ich bin ein millionaire. Ich bin ein seriously loaded multimillionaire."

Continued Kennedy: "I hope to increase the exchange of great ideas between our nations. Although, I must admit, I have the advantage of receiving an education far superior to most of yours—and, in fact, to most anyone's. Ich bin ein privileged, blue-blood Harvard man."

"We must work hard in these difficult times to further the ideals of democracy and stand

firm in the face of encroaching Communism," Kennedy said, concluding his speech. "Actually, you must do this. I do not: Because of my great wealth and status, while America's best and brightest deal with the daily cares of national stewardship, I intend to split my time between hosting wild parties at Mafia-owned casinos and bedding starlets in my secret underground White House love bunker. For ich bin ein free-wheeling playboy."

Kennedy concluded by thanking those in attendance, whom he called, "You sausage-chomping Krauts who murdered my older brother Joe, who should have been president instead of me."

The speech, which was "very well-received," according to West Berlin Mayor Willy Brandt, is regarded as even more rousing than Kennedy's "Je suis un damn handsome sonofabitch" address in Paris last Friday.

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## ALLEN FUNT LETS PRESIDENT IN ON HILARIOUS 'CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS' PRANK

### Relieved Kennedy Laughs Heartily after Learning of Elaborate International Gag

### JFK a Good Sport, Says Host of TV's *Candid Camera*

WASHINGTON, D.C.—A period of intense national tittering came to a hilarious end early Monday morning, when notorious prankster and *Candid Camera* host Allen Funt ended his most elaborate gag to date by letting President Kennedy in on the "Cuban Missile Crisis" that has kept America in stitches since last week.

Following a briefing by the "Joint Chiefs of Staff" (in actuality, professional actors) about the latest developments in the crisis, Kennedy was surprised by a loud knock at the Oval Office door. Funt, who has passed himself off as Nikita Khrushchev for the last two weeks in a series of increasingly implausible televised speeches, walked unimpeded through a phalanx of "Secret Service agents" and approached the president.

"Didn't mean to 'rush-in' like

that, Comrade Presidentski," a straight-faced, Russian-accented Funt told the president, "but I am havink somethink important with vich to be tellink you."

According to Arthur Schlesinger Jr., special advisor to the president and one of the prank's principal conspirators, the confused Kennedy then turned to his brother, Attorney General Robert Kennedy, who had "turned beet-red and was biting his knuckle" to keep from bursting into laughter.

"At that point," Schlesinger said, "I think Jack figured out something was up."

Funt then pointed to a portrait of Lincoln hanging on the wall. "Vee hef been spyink on you zis whole time," the would-be Soviet premier told Kennedy, "through zat portrait. Vee hef caught you on film from ze

beginning of zis crisis. Only, perhaps it is not so big a crisis as you thought, no?"

National Security Affairs Special Assistant McGeorge Bundy proceeded to remove the picture, revealing a smiling, waving cameraman. As the room exploded in laughter, the commander-in-chief finally figured it out. "I don't believe it!" the embarrassed president said. "*Candid Camera!* And all of you knew? You guys! All right, you got me. I admit it, you got me."

"I've been planning this one since election night, 1960," said Funt, speaking to a White House press corps which, since March 16, 1961, has played along with him, dutifully reporting the latest "news" of the crisis. "But it got kicked into high gear after the Bay of Pigs. I think JFK kept waiting for the camera to pop up after that happened. Once he believed the situation was real, I knew his guard would be down. Still, it took me and [Defense Secretary] Bob [McNamara] months to come up with just the right scenario. I wanted to make sure we really zinged him. But give a lot of credit to Jackie, Bobby, the Cabinet, and a seemingly terrified public. They went along with the whole thing beautifully."

Kennedy praised the prank as "the funniest oval-office gag since the squirting red phone."

A two-hour collection of highlights of Kennedy's reactions to the crisis will be broadcast on CBS next Tuesday at 8 p.m. EST. "I'm going to co-host it with the president himself," said Funt. "He's going to take me through his thoughts as we watch him agonize about the nation's future. He's handled the whole thing with the humor and good grace. It's like I've always said: There's nothing more refreshing than a little egg on the face!"

## Art Critics Call Campbell's New Tomato Soup 'Brilliant'

### Soup Maker Hailed for 'Pop Art' Commentary on Rampant Commercialism in American Culture

12-Ounce Can Fetches \$100,000 at Manhattan Grocery Store

Campbell's Soup is drawing rave reviews from the world's art critics, who hail the soup maker's new "Tomato" soup "a brilliant post-modern commentary on the all-pervasiveness of consumerism in modern life."

Art dealers from New York to Paris are bidding astronomical sums for the 12-ounce cans, normally priced at 33 cents. This week, a can at a Manhattan grocery fetched \$100,000.

According to New York art collector Manfred Havill, who paid \$80,000 for a can at Sol's Corner Grocery in Queens Friday, "This soup savagely lampoons the unwelcome, insidious intrusion of crass commercialism into everyday life and modern popular culture. This is Campbell's greatest masterpiece since 'Cream of Mushroom.'"

The art originates from a small collective of artists calling them-



selves "The Campbell's Canning Factory" in Gary, Indiana.

Campbell's Soup CEO Herbert Leonard, 53, said he is mystified by the success of the can.

"It's just soup," Leonard said. "My company's products have no more artistic significance than, say, a box of Brillo pads."

## Hoover Vows to Stop Martin Luther King Jr.'s Dangerous Non-Violence Movement

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Citing "a grave threat to the well-being of all Americans," FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced Sunday that he will do "whatever it takes" to stop the non-violent peace movement of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

"America has bravely stood up to countless threats throughout its history, from British imperialism to the Axis Powers of World War II," Hoover said. "But never have we faced something so insidious as King's campaign of change through voting, non-violent demonstrations, and preaching 'love thy neighbor.'"

"There is no place for this dangerous idea of 'love' in the United States," Hoover said.

According to Hoover, "This agitator King, driven by an insatiable lust for respect and equality, has used radical tactics ranging from boycotts to peaceful assembly."

According to Hoover, the boycott of local businesses, in which King and others refuse to patronize businesses which do not fall in line with their political beliefs, is a vicious, underhanded practice.

"A prolonged boycott can send the message to a business owner, 'I do not want to patronize your business, because I do not agree with your policies.' Is this the kind of consumer we want? One who would make such demands of the hard-working American businessman? I think not."

Equally chilling, said Hoover, is the "sit-down strike," in which King lackeys not only sit down in a pre-selected location, but refuse to move, letting nothing dissuade them from their cruel dictate. "These negro trouble-makers have been known to sit at a lunch counter, order a sandwich, and sit and eat it, sometimes occupying the seat for up to 40 minutes," Hoover said.

But perhaps the most dangerous practice of King's thugs, the FBI director said, is the "march." "King's horrifying marches," Hoover said, "unleash vast hordes of civil-rights protesters on the streets and byways of America, thousands of pairs of feet striking the pavement in an unyielding pageant of terror."

To combat the menace, Hoover has asked Congress for \$4 million to fund remote-surveillance equipment to monitor King's sexual activities.

## James Meredith Becomes First Negro Student Beaten at U. of Miss.

OXFORD, Miss.—James Meredith, who made national news last month when he became the first negro student to enroll at the University of Mississippi, broke down yet another barrier Sunday when he became the first negro student beaten at the school.

The historic beating took place at 1:30 a.m. EST, in Meredith's Baxter Hall dormitory room. According to reports, Meredith was asleep when a group of approximately 20 unidentified male students broke into his room and attacked him with fists and baseball bats until campus police broke up the brawl four hours later.

"This is a first for Ole Miss and a momentous day for the state of Mississippi," Gov. Ross Barnett said of the campus' first-ever

negro-student beating. "Walls are truly coming down."

Despite the beating, as well as the awkwardness of being flanked by U.S. Marshals at all times while on campus, Meredith is enjoying his experience at the University of Mississippi, school officials said.

"In accordance with last month's Supreme Court ruling, Mr. Meredith is enjoying the company of a great many federally enforced friends," said Ole Miss Dean of Students Richard Hughes.

"I think he's a great guy and a terrific pal," said freshman Larry Madsen under a federal court order.

Meredith said that, in the coming year, he hopes to avoid becoming the first negro student lynched at Ole Miss.

## SINATRA WARNS RUSSKIES TO KNOCK IT OFF

**Singer Gives Khrushchev 24 Hours to 'Drop This Commie Bunk or It's Ring-a-Ding-Ding for You Bozos'**

**Calls Soviet Premier a 'World-Class Knucklehead'**

LAS VEGAS—With Communism continuing to spread across the globe from Cuba to Indochina, singer Frank Sinatra issued a strongly worded ultimatum Tuesday from his penthouse suite at the Sands Hotel & Casino, warning Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev to "Knock it off, or I'll knock it off for you, buster."

"If those clowns over at the Politburo don't cut this Communism bunk ASAP, I'm gonna have no choice but to crack some

skulls," said Sinatra, surrounded by an entourage of business associates and close friends, including Dean Martin, Sammy Davis Jr. and Peter Lawford. "Nobody's gonna put up with this garbage while Frankie and his boys are in town."

Sinatra also had strong words for the Communist regime of North Vietnam and their funding of Vietcong guerrillas in the South. "You better watch it, too, gooks, if you know what's good for you. I don't have time for your slanty-eyed schemes."

Added Sinatra: "A Commie is just like a broad. You gotta make sure they know their place, or they'll walk all over you."

After giving the Russians 24 hours to withdraw all missiles from Eastern Europe, Sinatra concluded his press conference with a medley of Sammy Cahn tunes, including "All the Way," "Come Fly with Me" and "Call Me Irresponsible."

Sinatra first became involved in the fight against Communism last Friday, when President Kennedy called him to the White House for a top-secret one-on-one debriefing. Upon learning the full details of the situation, Sinatra urged Kennedy to let him "show those lousy pinkos who's boss" by deploying several key members of the Rat Pack

to Moscow to "knock some sense into Khrushchev and his jerko cronies."

"I'm sick of these Commie numbskulls and all their monkeying around in the Third World," Sinatra told Kennedy, according to a report in Tuesday's *Washington Post*. "Just give me and Dean five minutes with these bozos, and I guarantee you they'll be whistling a different tune."

Among the measures Sinatra called for during his two-hour meeting with Kennedy: an increased U.S. military presence in Southeast Asia, \$30 million to develop new surveillance technologies, and a double scotch on the rocks.

"These Russkies have been a pain in the neck long enough," Sinatra said. "We gotta show these punks who's running the show."

Sinatra said that before he makes any move, he plans to head down to the track at Santa Ana, where a certain pony in the ninth race is a shoo-in to make him some big bucks.

"This filly's name is Jubilee, and let's just say I have it on good authority that she's a can't-miss sweetheart bet at 20-to-1," Sinatra said. "Ava Gardner ain't got nothing on this little dame."

## U.S. Spies Discover What Lies Beneath Russian Nesting Dolls; 'It's More Dolls,' Says CIA Director

LANGLEY, Va.—CIA Director John McCone announced Tuesday that the agency has succeeded in revealing the secret locked inside the wooden Russian "nesting" doll knick-knacks.

"Inside these innocent-seeming dolls, crafted in the innocuous likeness of a babushka-clad Russian peasant woman, lurk more dolls," McCone said. "Each subsequent doll in this disturbing progression also bears the likeness of a member of a babushka-clad Russian peasant family. The disturbing implications of creeping Communist influence are obvious."

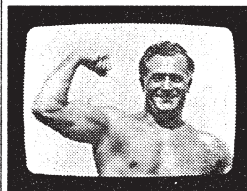
CIA officials said the dolls, samples of which were purchased



in the Russian neighborhood of Brighton Beach, New York, are "almost certainly" an anatomically accurate representation of an actual Russian. Plans have been made to surgically test this hypothesis on the next Russian captured by CIA operatives.

## Adlai Stevenson Sends Away for Charles Atlas Muscle-Building Plan

**Will General Westmoreland's Insult Make a Man out of Adlai?**

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Three-time failed presidential hopeful Adlai Stevenson, claiming that he is "fed up" with seeing the huskies walk off with the best of everything," filled out and mailed a magazine coupon for Charles Atlas' "Dynamic Tension" muscle-building plan Tuesday.

Stevenson's decision to build up his body in the natural way recommended by Atlas was made following events at Saturday's White House beach outing, when General William J. Westmoreland kicked sand in the face of Stevenson and his wife.

"I merely asked the general to stop kicking sand in our faces, and my wife commented that he was the worst nuisance on the beach," Stevenson said. Sources close to Stevenson report that Westmoreland replied by grasping him by his thin, stick-like arm and brandishing a fist menacingly.

"See here, beanpole," the general is reported as saying, "I oughta wallop you one right now—but you're so skinny you'd probably just dry up and blow away." He then laughed and ran off with a beach ball, leaving Stevenson shaken.

"I commented to Mrs. Stevenson that Westmoreland was a big bully, and that I'd get even some day," Stevenson said. "But she just said, 'Oh, don't let it bother you, little boy! That's when I became ashamed of my scrawny, 97-pound-runt frame.'"

Stevenson added that he is "sick and tired of being a scarecrow. And Charles Atlas says he can give me a real body! I decided to gamble a stamp and get his free book!"

Atlas, when asked what results Stevenson could expect, was optimistic.

"Dynamic Tension builds muscles fast!" said Atlas, who has been awarded the title of The World's Most Perfectly Developed Man. "Later, after building up his body the natural way—without springs, weights or pulleys—I expect

Adlai to stand in front of a mirror, flexing his powerful new muscles and saying to himself, 'Boy! It didn't take long for Atlas' plan to do this for me! What muscles! That General Westmoreland won't shove me around again!'"

Stevenson agreed with Atlas' predictions. "When next I confront the general, I won't be afraid," he said. "I'll say, 'What! You here again? Here's something I owe you!' and give him one on the chin." Stevenson noted that, along with Atlas' 32-page illustrated book, he would receive five free gifts: outline courses on jiu-jitsu/karate, boxing, wrestling, feats of strength and hang balancing, all of which would aid him in defeating even a skilled military man such as Westmoreland.

"Mrs. Stevenson will see that I am a real man, after all," said Stevenson. Passersby will say, 'Gosh! What a build!' and I'll soon be famous for it."

Stevenson would not comment on the possibility that he will become "hero of the beach."

## Jackie Kennedy Wins Nobel Hair Prize



First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy, renowned patron of the arts and internationally recognized fashion trendsetter, was awarded the prestigious Nobel Prize for Hair Tuesday.

Lauded by the Nobel Committee for her perfect coiffure and the important work she had done on her hair each morning, Kennedy is responsible for crucial advancements in follicle-body enhancement, having pioneered the innovative "bouffant" style.

Kennedy announced she will put the money toward the construction of the Jackie Institute, a facility dedicated to the development of better shampoos and more resilient hair sprays.

Kennedy won the Pulitzer last year for Most Distinguished Offsetting of Hat without Distracting from Hair.

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## Texas Instruments Continues Domination of Personal-Computing Field

With sales of its flagship TI-99/4a model topping \$45 million in the first quarter of 1981, Texas Instruments continues to dominate the personal-computing field, with no signs of slowing down any time soon.

"The TI-99 is, quite simply, the computer everyone wants," *Byte* magazine editor Charles Lathon said Friday. "And, with its help-button feature, built-in BASIC programming language and full set of graphics keys, it's not hard to see why."

The TI-99 has easily outsold all other home-computing systems in the \$150 to \$200 price range, including the Atari 400,

Odyssey 2 and Sinclair ZX81.

"Texas Instruments owns the home-computer field," CEO Christopher Pike said. "Everyone else—from Timex to Apple to Magnavox—is just

fighting for second place."

Industry watchers say that what gives the TI-99 its real edge over competitors is its impressive 16K of RAM.

"As personal computers go,

this is an extremely powerful machine, boasting enough memory to do almost anything," *Popular Computing's* Jonathan Wald said. "With 16K of RAM, it can meet the user's home-biorhythm-charting and recipe-filing needs, while still offering the 16 colors and 256x192 graphic resolution necessary to run Super Breakout."

Despite Texas Instruments' firm grip on the top spot, other home-computer manufacturers are trying to close the gap by aggressively introducing new features, such as arrow and backspace keys.

Radio Shack, another key player in the home-computer

industry, is offering a free software package with the TRS-80 Model III, including Checkbook Manager, Hangman and Oregon Trail, while the Commodore VIC-20 boasts a state-of-the-art cassette recorder for program storage.

However, Texas Instruments' CEO says he is not concerned. "We are hardly worried about a company like Radio Shack, or even upstart companies like Apple, with its II Plus," Pike said. "The TI-99, with its daisy-wheel printer, TV switch box and AC power adapter, is one of the most awesome computer set-ups money can buy. I challenge anyone to compete with it."

# Hinckley, Foster to Wed

## Actress 'Very Impressed' by Lone-Nut Gunman's Attempt on President's Life

NEW HAVEN, Conn.—Actress Jodie Foster, wowed by out-of-work machinist John Hinckley Jr.'s attempt on the life of President Reagan last week, announced plans Saturday to marry the gunman.

"I can't tell you how flattered I was. To think that someone would actually shoot the leader of the free world just for me," Foster said. "The moment I heard I was the reason he did it, I fell head-over-heels in love."

Foster said that when she found out her picture and a piece of paper with her name and address on it had been found on Hinckley's person at the time of the shooting, she

called him to ask if he wanted to get together.

"We went out to this little Italian restaurant and had the best time," the love-struck actress said. "I can't believe how well we hit it off."

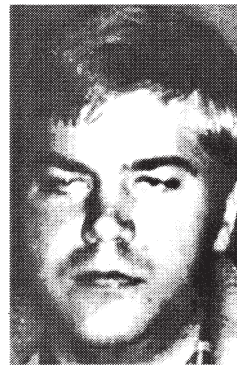
Hinckley had been familiar with Foster for years, first drawn to the actress after seeing her in Martin Scorsese's 1976 film *Taxi Driver*. "The first time I saw the movie, I said to myself, 'Someday I'm going to marry that girl,'" Hinckley told *People* magazine in an exclusive interview this week. "In order to do that, though, I knew I needed to really catch her eye."

After watching *Taxi Driver*

more than 600 times and plastering the walls of his home with magazine articles, photos and drawings of Foster, Hinckley devised various plans to win her love. When Foster failed to answer any of the 1,263 letters he had sent her and refused to answer his 56 daily phone calls, Hinckley knew his tactics were not aggressive enough.

It was at this point that Hinckley devised the idea to win Foster's love by assassinating the president.

The plan worked. "Although my bullet narrowly missed President Reagan's heart, Cupid's arrow hit Jodie's," Hinckley said.

"We've been inseparable ever since."

Foster, who had been attending Yale University prior to the shooting, recently dropped out to prepare for her marriage to the man she describes as "a big, lovable, president-shoot-



ing teddy bear." She said she has no plans to continue either her schooling or her acting career, and will instead focus on "building a life and a family with this wonderful, caring man."

A June wedding is planned.

## Lucasfilm Puppet Stands in for Wounded Reagan

SAN RAFAEL, Calif.—George Lucas' Industrial Light & Magic special-effects company has developed a \$62 million animatronic puppet to stand in for the wounded president at official state functions.

The puppet made its debut Friday at a state dinner for British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher. "I would like to extend a welcome to the leader of our longtime ally, as well as to the wonderful people of the United Kingdom," said puppeteer Frank Oz, voice of the replacement Reagan.

It takes six puppeteers to control the new president—two for the arms, two for the legs, one for the head and torso, and one whose face is covered with suction cups con-

nected by wire to a computer, which can duplicate up to eight basic facial expressions, transferring them perfectly onto the puppet.

The puppet is one of four created by ILM for upcoming presidential functions. Two miniature models, which can be manipulated through stop-motion photography, will be used for wider shots and are ideal for foreign parades and televised speeches.

The puppet's developers said there remain a few bugs to be worked out before the puppet is ready for arms-reduction talks with the Soviets, but they say they are confident that their Reagan is already an excellent stand-in president.

"By combining the eight facial expressions with the

puppet's body movements," head developer Phil Tippet said, "the Reagan puppet is capable of expressing some 32 emotions. That is twice the number attainable by the real President Reagan, and three times the number attainable by the Tauntaun creatures in *The Empire Strikes Back*."

The puppet has been warmly welcomed by Reagan Administration staffers, particularly his speechwriters, who have struggled to make the president appear healthy and confident despite his agonizing pain from being shot in the chest.

"Frank Oz is a talented puppeteer and performer who, because he is hidden from view during performances, can actually read directly from a script, rather than having to

memorize lines," speechwriter Peggy Noonan said. "That's something we could never do with President Reagan, and it's a major plus."

The Reagan puppet was made with flame-retardant foam covered with a space-age textured-polymer skin and sculpted by make-up artist Rick Baker, who created the alien creatures for *Star Wars*. It features over 30 miniature servo-motors in the face and head alone, and its eyes were modeled after Albert Einstein's.

Reagan Administration officials say the resemblance to the actual president is uncanny.

"When I ask for approval to sell nuclear weapons to our enemies in the Mideast, the puppet smiles at me, nods vacantly and signs any papers

I give him," National Security Advisor Robert McFarlane said. "It is eerie how similar he is to the real President Reagan."

ILM effects wizards are working on an even more advanced Reagan puppet to replace the president entirely by 1983.

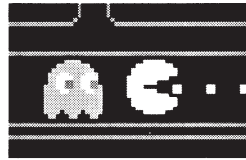

## Secret Pac-Man Patterns Fall Into Russian Hands



WASHINGTON, D.C.—CIA sources reported Wednesday that many of the Pentagon's most closely guarded Pac-Man patterns have fallen into Russian hands.

"We have reason to believe that KGB spies have obtained classified Pentagon blueprints detailing which way to go and when to eat the bonus fruit," CIA spokesman Benjamin Sirof said. "Using this sensitive information, the Russians may be able to get as far as the grapes, or perhaps even the Galaxian thing."

According to Sirof, the CIA first suspected the patterns had been stolen Dec. 2, 1980, when several agency operatives noticed that the Pac-Man machine at the U.N. had a new high score of 84,740.

"That beat the old high score by some 10,000 points. Nobody in the U.S. Gaming Forces

knew who had done it or when," Sirof said. "That led us to the ominous suspicion that the KGB is a 'fifth ghost' looming over American heads."

"The national-security implications of this are terrifying," said UCLA political-science professor Allen Meyers. "If Russian gamers knew where to go after the power pill in the upper left wears out and the ghosts turn back to their regular color, there would be no stopping them."

Pentagon officials are currently trying to learn the identity of a suspected KGB mole who may have forwarded reproductions of the classified documents to Russian agents, or may have watched Pentagon officials playing and then copied down their moves.

"We must not waver in the race to master Pac-Man," Secretary of State Alexander

Haig said following the disclosure. "With the release of the long-awaited sequel, Ms. Pac-Man, just months away, we must keep pace with global dot-consumption and acquisition of bonus fruits."

Added Haig: "We must remain forever vigilant. We must play Pac-Man until we go past the fabled 255th level and the screen goes crazy. And we must do so before the Soviets."

## CIA Unveils Cheaper, More Powerful Form of Cocaine

### 'Crack' Expected to Make Drug Addiction More Accessible to Inner-City Poor

LANGLEY, Va.—The CIA unveiled its latest mind-altering drug Wednesday: "crack," a concentrated, smokable form of cocaine.

Cheap and highly addictive, crack is expected to revolutionize drug addiction in America's blighted urban ghettos, CIA officials said.

"Our pharmacologists worked long and hard on this new drug, and, judging by the response from our test subjects, it was worth the wait," CIA Director William Casey said. "We expect America's minorities to be thoroughly ravaged by crack."

A multimedia presentation at CIA headquarters, attended by the mayors of nearly every major U.S. city, explained the differences between crack and conventional powdered cocaine.

"The crack high is much more intense, yet also much shorter,

than that of normal cocaine," said Casey, standing in front of a large video screen depicting an inner-city youth smoking crack out of a glass pipe. "This intensity, along with crack's low price and instant addictive qualities, creates a vicious cycle of dependency that often ends in violence for the user and his associates."

The Justice Department has thrown its support behind crack by making the possession of only five grams of the substance as serious an offense as the possession of 500 grams of powdered cocaine. "We hope to put an entire generation of young, poor men behind bars, while allowing America's privileged businessmen to stay wired and wealthy," Attorney General William French Smith said.

In addition to crippling America's inner cities, crack will be used to further the CIA's international agenda. "With the profits we collect from sales of this exciting new drug," Casey said, "we will have the opportunity to fund numerous Central American coups."

President Reagan reacted favorably when told of the new drug. "This crack sounds like just what America needs," he said.

## Nation's Air Traffic Controllers Executed

WASHINGTON, D.C.—President Reagan ordered America's air-traffic controllers put to death Wednesday, ending the group's six-day walkout.

The 13,000 members of the National Air-Traffic Controllers Union were electrocuted at 12:01 a.m. Reagan made the decision after a brief meeting with Transportation Secretary Drew Lewis, who strongly supported the president's action.

"I could not allow a strike by the people we depend upon to

safely control the flow of airline traffic," Reagan said. "Air travelers' lives are in these people's hands. If they had been allowed to continue striking, people could have been killed."

Special electric chairs were set up at airports across the country to execute the strikers. Air-traffic controllers formed long execution lines, with death delays of up to three hours reported at Chicago's O'Hare International, and more than six hours at New York's LaGuardia Airport.

## Fairytale Wedding Distracts Rank-and-File

### Economically Ravaged British Underclass Temporarily Forgets Miserable Lives

LONDON, England—Lady Diana Spencer and Prince Charles Philip Arthur George of Wales were married Wednesday in a fairytale wedding that temporarily distracted the teeming, dirt-faced hordes of British commoners from their dreary, destitute lives.

Captivated by the picture-book event, held at St. Paul's Cathedral, England's faceless rabble momentarily forgot about the country's high taxes, runaway inflation, stratified class structure, stagnant manufacturing base and rapidly plummeting position in the world economy.

Instead, they focused on the jewel-bedecked couple, who left Buckingham Palace in a majestic, diamond-studded coach following a stately, opulent procession of gleaming black Rolls Royces carrying the crowned heads of Europe.

During the hours-long procession to St. Paul's, the royals passed hundreds of thousands of out-of-work coal miners stricken with black-lung disease. Many had camped out overnight in the hope of catching a glimpse of the bride and groom.

"This truly is a magical day," said George Livesey, an unemployed Sheffield mill worker who could feed his family for 437 years for the price of the royal wedding ring.

Of course, the massive unemployment crippling the working class was the last thing on the minds of the masses as they gazed upon Lady Diana's gown, which trailed a 25-foot train made of bantam-weight crisp ivory silk taffeta and old

lace dipped in solid gold. "How lovely she looks," said Francine Chisholm, a £1.50-an-hour maid who watched the wedding on a television in the shop window near her rat-infested two-room flat. "I'm weeping tears of joy."

Following the resplendent multimillion-dollar event, the bottom 94 percent of England's wage-earners returned to their lives of abject squalor.

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# Grenada-Falklands Superpower Alliance Mobilizes for War

## Falklands' Elite Puffin Brigade Poised to Attack U.S., U.K.

## Grenada Rumored to Have More Than 12 Guns

LONDON—Hours after learning of the alliance signed between Grenada and the Falkland Islands Sunday, President Reagan flew to London for an emergency meeting with Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher.

"Grenada and the Falklands are a pair of bloodthirsty aggressors, intent on conquering all of the Western Hemisphere," Thatcher told reporters following the meeting. "We must learn the lesson of the Munich Conference and not appease these bullies as Chamberlain did Hitler."

Reagan and Thatcher met for more than four hours, affirming their commitment to defending each other from the Grenada-Falklands menace. The pair also conferred with Allied command leaders, devising a preliminary defense strategy in case the South American superpowers follow through on their threat to throw pebbles at the U.S.

The two island nations formalized their alliance during a meeting in the capital city of Stanley on East Falkland Island. Signing the military pact, Grenadan Prime Minister Maurice Bishop pledged full support to the Falklands, vowing to send all six Grenadan soldiers into battle, if necessary.

"Our soldiers are very big," Bishop said. "One of them, Claude Dumont, placed second at the 1981 Pan-Caribbean Arm-Wrestling Championships."

Bishop also said he would position the Grenadan Navy's top battleship off the coast of Florida in preparation for an assault on the U.S.

For their part, the Falklanders promised they would back up Grenada if it went to war with the U.S. by dispatching their elite Puffin Brigade.

"Our fierce aquatic birds will rain terror upon the U.S.," Falkland Islands General Eduardo Villacruz said. "There is no escaping their onslaught of squawking and flapping."

Military experts estimate that, if the U.S. and Britain

were to go to war with the island power bloc, the number of soldiers injured could reach the high single digits.

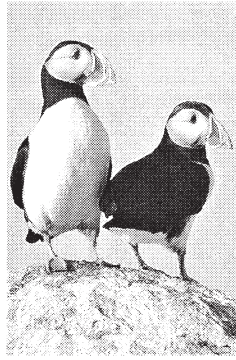
"There is a lot of rocky terrain in both Grenada and the Falklands, so if we were to invade either nation, there definitely would be some sprained ankles and pulled calf muscles," said former U.S. Army Sgt. Gene Hastings (Ret.). "I would urge soldiers to be careful and take each step slowly. And be sure to stretch out for at least 10 minutes before engaging in strenuous fighting. The last thing we want is someone getting hurt."

## John Denver's Career in Ruins Following Tryst with Muppet

LONDON—Popular singer/songwriter John Denver's career is in serious jeopardy following his arrest Sunday in connection with alleged sexual relations with a female Muppet.

Denver, who was in London to tape a guest-host appearance on *The Muppet Show*, was arrested after an anonymous tip led authorities to his hotel suite at the Sheraton Park Lane, where, according to a police spokesman, he was caught engaging in "an act of illicit congress" with Janice, a Muppet guitarist with the band Dr. Teeth & The Electric Mayhem.

Jim Henson, creator of *The Muppet Show*, said he is "deeply saddened by the news, if it is true," but urged the public not to rush to judge Denver. Henson did not say whether

next week's show would be canceled, postponed or re-taped with a new guest host.

Speaking to reporters from his jail cell, Denver said, "I have no comment other than that I am innocent of any wrongdoing."

Denver, whose hits include "Rocky Mountain High" and

"Sunshine on My Shoulders," will be arraigned Friday. His trial could begin as soon as October.

Janice was not arrested in the incident and is reportedly in seclusion.

Dr. Teeth, leader of the Muppet band and a close friend of Janice's, said Janice was feeling "a little down in the skin but basically groovy-woovy."

Teeth also said he is confident that any sexual act which may have occurred between Janice and Denver would have been 100 percent consensual. "Gotta cut out the fuzz, slack," he said. "The man and the Muppet have had the love bug since Miles Davis was Yards Davis, you dig?"

Another band member, identified only as the drummer, responded angrily to news of Denver's arrest, flailing wildly and screaming incoherently while throwing furniture, props and this week's guest host, Carol Burnett, around the Muppet Theater.

## Reagan to Meet with Master Control Program

WASHINGTON, D.C.—After years of one-on-one flying-disc dueling against MCP drones, President Reagan will finally attend a historic summit with ENCOM's Master Control Program next month, a White House spokesman confirmed Sunday.

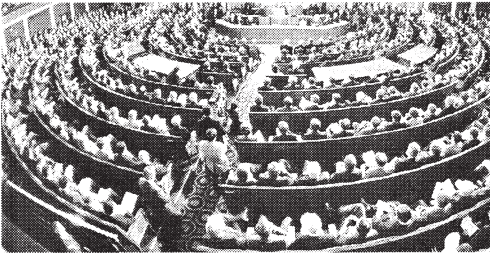
Quipped Reagan, "If the Master Control Program can't come clean about user-rights abuses, it will be 'end of line' for our negotiations."

Wald, editor of *Popular Computing*. "You have to realize that Dillinger created the runaway-hit video game Space Paranoids, a game boasting realistically shaded, 3D-rendered polygon graphics at a level of sophistication light-years beyond any other video game. This game's graphics are so spectacular, they make Asteroids look primitive."



## Congress Allocates \$300 Billion to Nation's Rich

WASHINGTON, D.C.— President Reagan's "trickle-down" economic policy continued Friday when Congress approved legislation allocating \$300 billion in tax-free funding to the nation's rich.

Distribution of funds begins at the start of the 1983-84 fiscal year. Under the terms of the legislation, the wealthiest .05 percent of American citizens will receive funding first. "Everyone knows the old saying, 'When the rich get richer,

the poor get richer, as well,'" said Reagan, voicing his approval of the measure. "By pouring such a great deal of money into the most well-off among us, we improve conditions for all Americans."

"Thank God," said Pierre DuPont, 47, heir to the DuPont chemical fortune. "At last, dozens of Americans like me won't have to endure the awful inconveniences we suffered under Carter."

DuPont had held a cham-

pagne-and-candlelight vigil at his Delaware mansion while the measure was in subcommittee.

"Winston! More cognac!" DuPont added, clapping his hands imperiously toward one of his servants.

Rich Americans plan to reinvest the federally promised money in already-bloated trust funds, banks in which they hold interests and companies in which they are majority shareholders.

## MIT Scientists Have Three Sides of Rubik's Cube Complete

CAMBRIDGE, Mass.—A team of MIT physicists announced Sunday that it has completed the vital third side of the Rubik's Cube, bringing it ever closer to solving the puzzle.

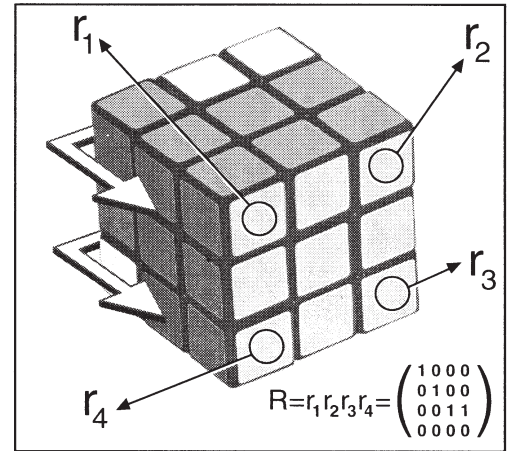
"This represents a major breakthrough," said exhausted, red-knuckled project leader Dr. Cedric Stephens. "With this critical triad completed, there is reason to believe we can complete the final sides by perhaps even December of this year."

The scientists credited the breakthrough to a shift in their approach to the multi-colored cube. Previously, they had focused their efforts on the center-most square on each side of the puzzle. But team member Dr. Jim Barstow suggested the group concentrate on the four outer corners while closely monitoring the position of each square on the reverse side of the cube during each

turn. "It was the classic example of being too close to a problem to see the solution," Barstow said. "Only by stepping back and rethinking our whole way of looking at the cube could we ultimately move forward."

Barstow said it is "too soon to tell" if this strategic shift could be applied to other hand-held twist puzzles, including the Snake, Pyraminx and Missing Link.

If the MIT team completes the Rubik's Cube, its members will be the first people in the world ever to do so. A team of University of Berlin physicists reported solving the puzzle last November, but, upon close examination of the cube by

Rubik Institute officials, it was discovered that the German scientists had illegally removed the stickers and reapplied them in their proper places.

A Japanese scientist at the

University of Tokyo similarly claimed to have solved the puzzle last month, but he, too, was exposed as a fraud when he was found to have pulled the cube apart and snapped it back together correctly.

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## Ayatollah Calls \$3.1 Million for Medium-Range Missile 'Ridiculous'; Tells Reagan \$2.5 Million Is Final Offer

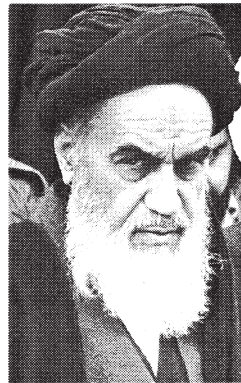
TEHRAN—Lashing out against the latest arms-trade offer made to him by the U.S. government, the Ayatollah Khomeini called America's asking price of \$3.1 million for medium-range surface-to-surface missiles "ridiculous" Sunday, threatening to take his business elsewhere if a fairer price could not be agreed upon immediately.

"I was under the impression that Mr. Reagan was going to give me a fair deal," the Iranian leader said. "I thought we had a mutually satisfactory business relationship. But the price he has quoted me is too high for Iran to afford."

"What do they think that I am," he asked, "made of money?"

Khomeini has made a counteroffer of \$2.5 million per missile, a price President Reagan said is not being considered.

Reagan, reiterating longtime administration policy, told

reporters, "America does not negotiate any lower than \$2.75 million with terrorists. The United States government has

its bottom line to consider. How does the Ayatollah expect us to support our right-wing death squads in Central America?"

"Secretary of Defense [Caspar] Weinberger and Secretary of State [George] Shultz didn't even want to give Khomeini this much of a bargain," Vice President George Bush said. "He should know that, if it were up to those guys, this deal wouldn't even be on the table. We really are doing the best we can here."

Khomeini, who said he has been "an excellent customer" of Reagan's in the past, and has never been late paying for missiles, strongly hinted that the latest asking price might give him cause to cool business dealings with the U.S.

"The United States may be the Great Satan, but it offers the best bargains on state-of-the-art weapons, and for this reason we have always been able to reach an understand-

ing," Khomeini said. "But if a deal cannot be reached, I see no reason why I should not take my money elsewhere."

Those brokering the deal on the American side say the Ayatollah has lost sight of the spirit which drove the original bargain.

"The man must realize that the missiles are part of a package," said Lt. Col. Oliver North, who is in charge of delivering the massive arms shipment, of which the missiles are a part. "If we go down on the medium-range missiles, we have to go up on the surface-to-air missiles. If we stay low on both of those, we go up on the F-14s or the nerve gas, or even the plutonium. Business is business."

Said Khomeini, "We want the same things: You need money for your death squads; I need money for my global campaign of terror. For goodness' sake, let's be reasonable men."
